

2012 Mid-Ohio DE Lapping Day Addendum

This document Lapping Day details for Friday September 14, 2012. This information is supplemental to the Driver Information Packet. If you have not run Mid-Ohio or with ARPCA before please take a few minutes and read through the Driver Information Packet.

Announcements & Key Reminders

- **LD Registration:** Car Safety Checks occur in Garage 9 and Registration is in Garage 7. These are open Friday from 7:00 AM to 7:45 AM. Complete the Car Safety Check first (if you are not an instructor) then proceed to Registration. At Registration you will:
 - Turn in your approved Safety Inspection form,
 - Garage Rental Agreement, if appropriate, and
 - Show your driver's license.
- **Thursday Trailer Drop:** We have arranged with the track so we can drop our trailers Thursday afternoon from 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM. Parking of tow vehicles and trailers is restricted to the paddock side of the garages. Allow plenty of space for clockwise traffic flow around the garages.

Unless you have rented a garage, there will be no parking in front of the garages on the paddock side. You will have to park in the upper paddock, along the upper edge of the lower paddock, in the limited space by the concession stand, or in the open area by garages 21-28.

- **Friday on-track Schedule:** Drivers Meeting is at 7:45 in front of garage 7. The on-track driving will be from 8:00AM till 4:30 PM with a break between 12:00 and 1:00. While the track is open, you are free to stay on the track for as long as you are comfortable. Please remember, if you're getting tired come in for a rest. This is a long day.
- **Special Guest – Dennis Macchio:** We are excited to announce that Dennis (who runs the Bertil Roos Drivers School) will be attending our event. He will be leading two activities:
 - **30 & 60 minute coaching sessions on Friday.** These sessions are open to everyone attending LD
 - **30 minute coaching sessions on Saturday and Sunday.** These sessions are open to Instructors, A, and B students.Signup will be managed at the track on Friday.
- **Points to keep in mind:**
 - At LD we will observe the PCA Expanded Passing rules. With Expanded Passing, no passing occurs until the car in front signals you with a "point-by." Once you have been signaled by you can pass anywhere on the track (including turns.)
 - Normal flag rules will apply.
 - You will likely be on the track longer than at any TWO COMBINED driver's schools. Make sure you check your car over carefully after each session (tires, brakes, fluids, etc.).
 - While people who are normally students will not have assigned instructors, you are encouraged to ask for an instructor to ride with you for help.
 - If two people are in the car, one HAS to be one of our instructors. BOTH have to be lapping day registrants; no "non-student" rides.

Overly aggressive driving or ignoring of our driving rules will result in a request to leave the lapping day and the subsequent driver's education weekend. This is at the COMPLETE discretion of event management.
