

2012 WGI DE Lapping Day Addendum

This document provides specific Lapping Day details for Friday May 11, 2012. This information is supplemental to the Driver Information Packet

Announcements & Key Reminders

- **Thursday evening Trailer Drop:** We have arranged with WGI to allow those of you who will trailer your vehicle up to the Glen to drop off your trailer and unload your car between 6:00 – 8:00 PM.

Important Notes:

- No registration Thursday evening: We are just getting into to the Glen at the same time you are...
- No access to Garages: If you've rented a garage will not have access until Friday morning (after you sign the rental agreement...)

- **LD Registration:** Car Safety Checks occur in Garages 1 & 2. We are open Friday from 7:00 AM to 7:45 AM. Note: you will not have access to the track before 6:30 AM Friday morning. Complete the Car Safety Check first (if you are not an instructor) then proceed to Registration. At Registration you will:
 - Turn in your approved Safety Inspection form and
 - Show your driver's license.

Note: We require SNELL Rated **SA2005 or newer Helmets.**

- **Garages:** If you have rented a garage, you will need to register and sign the Garage Rental Form before unpacking in your garage.
- **Friday on-track Schedule:** Drivers Meeting is at 8:00 in the area of Garage 1 & 2. The on-track driving will be from 8:30 AM till 4:30 PM with a break between 12:00 and 1:00. While the track is open, you are free to stay on the track for as long as you are comfortable. Please remember, if you're getting tired come in for a rest. This is a long day
- **Track Walk Friday from 5:15 PM – 6:15 PM.** We had a great success with a track walk at Mid-Ohio so we have decided to add this to our event at The Glen. We were able to schedule this from 5:15 PM – 6:15 PM Friday Evening. Ken Pryor, one of our instructors and a very successful PCA club racer will be leading the walk/discussion.
- **Points to keep in mind:**
 - At LD we will observe the PCA Expanded Passing rules. With Expanded Passing, no passing occurs until the car in front signals you with a "point-by." Once you have been signaled by you can pass anywhere on the track (including turns.)
 - Normal flag rules will apply.
 - You will likely be on the track longer than at any TWO COMBINED driver's schools. Make sure you check your car over carefully after each session (tires, brakes, fluids, etc.).
 - While people who are normally students will not have assigned instructors, you are encouraged to ask for an instructor to ride with you for help.
 - If two people are in the car, one HAS to be one of our instructors. BOTH have to be lapping day registrants; no "non-student" rides.

Overly aggressive driving or ignoring of our driving rules will result in a request to leave the lapping day and the subsequent driver's education weekend. This is at the COMPLETE discretion of event management.
